At least 32 die in Siberia crash

Russian officials said 32 people were killed when a passenger plane crashed shortly after takeoff in eastern Siberia.

The French-madeATR-72 twin-engine turbo-prop operated by UTair was flying from Tyumen to the oil town of Surgut. Officials said 30 passengers and four crew were aboard.
